Mary Jones World is set in a tranquil location on the edge of Llyn Tegid and has a picnic area, children's playground and café.

In 1800, after saving for six years, Mary Jones walked 26 miles from Llanfihangel-y-Pennant to Bala to buy a book.

What was that book? And why did her journey inspire a movement that is still thriving today?

Mary Jones World is based in the historic St Beuno's Church. It tells the story of Mary Jones and Thomas Charles, and the impact of the world's best-selling book – the Bible – on Wales and the world.

Ample parking is available. There's no charge for parking, but please note that the car park facilities are for visitors to the centre and café only and that the gates will be locked at 4.30 pm.


