C Olwyn Ddŵr Maesycriau

Yn gynnar yn y 20fed ganrif, ychwanegwyd olwyn ddŵr at y beudy i droi'r peiriannau dyrnu (i wahanu'r grawn mewn cnydau megis gwenith).

D Ceinws

Daeth Canolfan Ddiwydiannol Dyfi, Ceinws, a adeiladwyd ar gyfer y di-waith (o Lerpwl yn bennaf), i ddywyo'r Comisiwn Coedwigaeth, gan ddod yn ganolfan ar gyfer gweithrediadau Coedwig Dyfi. Roedd yno 14 o dai ar gyfer coedwigwyr a gweithwyr coedwig ynghyd ag eglwys, neuadd bentref, llyfrgell, a modurdy. Roedd y Gwersyll yn gymuned o'r iawn ryw, ond bellach nid yw'n cael ei defnyddio ar y cyfan, heblaw am fel storfa.

Ar un tro roedd Llanwrin yn gymuned ffyniannus, gyda gof, tafarn a siop y pentref, ond mae'r cyfan wedi cau ers achau.

A The Dyfi

Good views of the river.

B Llanwrin

The village is named after its church, dedicated to St Gwrin which dates from late medieval times and was last restored in 1864. The churchyard is circular, often indicating an ancient foundation.

Once a thriving community with its own blacksmith, pub and village shop, all have long since closed.

C Waterwheel at Maesycriau

During the early 20th century a waterwheel was added to the cow house to power machinery for threshing (separate the grain from the rest of a crop such as wheat).

D Ceinws

The Dovey Instructional Centre at Ceinws, originally constructed for the unemployed (many from Liverpool), was taken over by the Forestry Commission and became the centre of operations for Dyfi Forest. There were fourteen houses for the foresters and forest workers, a church, village hall, library, and a garage. The camp was a community in itself, but is now largely unused, apart from storage.



Taith Ceinws - Llanwrin Walk



1 O'r blwch ffôn, trowch i'r chwith i fyny'r bryn - mae'r arwyddost yn cyfeirio at Ael-y-bryn. Ewch ymlaen trwy giât a dilyn y trac i fyny. Ychydig cyn i chi gyrraedd ail giât, trowch i'r dde i fyny'r banc gan ddilyn y ffens ar y chwith i gerdded o gwmpas cefn y tý cyn troi i'r chwith, ac wedyn i'r dde, i ddilyn llwybr i lawr y banc i groesi nant fach. Dilynwch y lôn werdd o gwmpas ochr y bryn cyn troi i'r chwith trwy giât i gerdded yn groeslinol i lawr y bryn i groesi pompren.

2 Cerddwch i fyny i'r ffordd a throwch i'r dde, wedyn yn syth ymlaen tan i chi gyrraedd cilfan fawr ar y chwith a dwy bont ar y dde. Ewch dros y bompren bellaf gan gerdded i'r chwith i fyny'r bryn trwy giât. Pan ddaw'r trac allan ar drac arall, trowch i'r chwith i fynd trwy giât a chroesi nant.

3 Ychydig cyn adfeillion Cae Cwta, trowch yn sydyn i'r dde i fyny ac i mewn i'r coed. Ar ddiwedd y coetir, ewch trwy giât a cherdded i fyny'r bryn i fynd trwy fynedfa giât ar y chwith cyn troi ychydig i'r chwith i ddilyn trac anamlwg. Ewch trwy giât a cherdded ar hyd llwybr dynodedig i gyrraedd trac clir wrth giât. Ewch trwy'r giât gan ddilyn y trac i lawr trwy giâtiau i gyrraedd lôn tarmac.

4 Trowch i'r dde ac wedyn yn syth i'r chwith i gerdded i fyny trwy giât ac ymlaen heibio tai allan Ysgubor Fraithwen. Ewch trwy'r giât ar y chwith ac wedyn giât arall ymhellach ymlaen cyn cymryd y llwybr i'r chwith o flaen giât arall i ddilyn y llwybr i fyny'r bryn. Gyda'r ffens ar y dde, ewch trwy giât mochyn ac wedyn dilynwch y ffens ar y chwith i fynd trwy giât arall. Pan gyrraedd dwch ddiwedd y ffens, ewch yn syth ymlaen i fynd i lawr y bryn trwy'r giât ar y chwith A. Gyda'r gwrych ar y chwith, ewch yn syth ymlaen i fynd i lawr trwy giât arall ac wedyn daliwch i gerdded i lawr tuag at gornel dde'r cae ar y gwaelod, i gerdded i lawr y banc.

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Start: Ceinws village
Grid Reference: SH760 059
Distance: 11.3 km - 7 miles (additional 0.7km - 0.4 miles to Llanwrin)
Grade: Moderate / Strenuous
Terrain: Firm tracks, open fields
Maps: OS Explorer 215
Refreshments: Dwynant Pub at Ceinws

1 From the telephone kiosk turn L uphill signposted Ael-y-bryn. Walk ahead to go through a G, and follow the track up. Just before you reach a second G veer R up the bank and follow the fence on your L to walk around the back of the house before turning L, then R to follow a path down the bank to cross a small stream. Follow the green lane around the side of the hill before turning L through a G to walk diagonally downhill to cross a FB.

2 Walk up to the road and turn R, then continue until you reach a large lay-by on your L and two bridges on your R. Cross the furthest wooden FB and walk L uphill through a G. Where the track emerges on to another track, turn L to go through a G and cross stream.

3 Just before Cae Cwta ruin, turn sharp R up into the trees. At the end of the woodland go through a G and walk uphill to go through L gateway then continue up veering L to follow a faint track. Go through a G, and walk along a defined path to reach a clear track at a G. Go through the G and follow the track down through Gs to reach a tarmac lane.

4 Turn R then immediately L to walk up through G and on past outbuildings at Ysgubor Fraithwen. Go through the G on L, then another G further on before forking L in front of another G to follow the path uphill. Walking with the fence on your R go through a kissing G, then follow LH fence to go through another G. When you reach the end of the fence, continue ahead to go downhill through L hand G A. With the hedge on your L continue down to go through another G, then on down towards the bottom RH corner of the field, to walk down the bank.

5 At the end of the fence just after the 3rd G, turn R downhill D. Keep the fence on your R to go through a G at the bottom of the field, before retracing your steps around the side of house and back to the start.
